This policy is applicable across the whole school including those pupils in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Principles

Assessment plays an important role in learning, enabling pupils, teachers and parents to understand a child's progress so that strengths and weaknesses can be identified, and appropriate action taken to ensure that they can then exceed their immediate academic performance and become even more successful learners. Constructive feedback (cf. Feedback & Marking Policy) is a critical component of the assessment process allowing ongoing dialogue between teachers, parents and pupils, providing learners with the motivation, support and skills to improve and progress. The process of assessment can also contribute to the evaluation of the effectiveness of teaching and learning (cf. Teaching & Learning Policy).

Format

Pupils in all year groups should be set regular activities, tasks and assignments which enable a range of assessment opportunities that should be appropriately marked in accordance with the Feedback & Marking Policy. Assessment can be: formative, providing information about the effectiveness of teaching and learning and helping pupils to think critically about how they are learning and identifying areas for improvement; summative, providing an indication of the level of a pupil's attainment at a particular point in time; and, diagnostic, helping to identify any barriers to learning and progress.

Schedule

The assessment schedule across the whole school is planned on an annual basis as shown in the Assessment Mapping document (see below); this provides an overview of the timing and type of assessment for each year group over the academic year. Standardised assessments (e.g. GL, MidYis, Yellis and ALIS tests) provide baseline data for comparison with nationally standardised norms that can be used to measure pupil progress and provide predicted grades when relevant, which can then be used to inform pupils, staff and parents of expected outcomes. In Years 1 to 8, these assessments cover attainment in Maths and English as well as potential ability through Cognitive Ability Tests (CAT). In Year 9 pupils take the University of Durham (CEM) MidYIS assessment from which target grades are generated at the start of Year 10. Pupils joining the school during or post Year 9 take CEM Yellis assessments. Likewise, Lower Sixth pupils take the CEM ALIS tests from which target grades are created. The style of other assessments and the exact date on which these are taken by pupils in any given term are determined at section, department and teacher level.

Recording

Data from assessments are recorded in appropriate tracking documents and processed in order to measure progress and identify whether a pupil is in line with, exceeding or falling short of expected progress. This data is then available to inform subject teachers, Heads of Departments, pastoral staff, the SMT and the SLT of pupil progress; this should then, subsequently, inform teaching and intervention strategies as appropriate and necessary for individual pupils. All teaching staff are expected to keep a simple clear record of marks achieved by pupils throughout the year. The format of the record is decided at department and teacher level and can be handwritten or digital, and kept securely in line with the school's information security and data protection arrangements.

Reporting

Written reports, grade cards and parents' meetings are arranged at regular intervals throughout the academic year (outlined in the Reporting and Assessment Schedule document, see below and found on the Portal) to provide opportunities for feedback to pupils and parents on pupil progress and learning.
